To report an emergency at Perth HPC, contact:

During an Incident
 Duty Officer becomes Chief Warden
 Chief Warden request all radios to Channel 1

Emergency Alert Buttons – Persons within the pool facilities have access to the emergency alert buttons that will immediately notify the pool supervisor of an emergency.
 Located at Outdoor 8 & 10 Lane Pools, Dive Pool behind dive towers, and Water Polo Pool.

When the alert tone sounds:

- Turn two-way radios to channel 1.
- Wardens report to your nearest Warden Station.

When the evacuation tone sounds:

- Follow Chief Warden's and Warden instructions.
- Commence required evacuation procedure.
- Maintain radio silence and await instructions from Chief Warden.



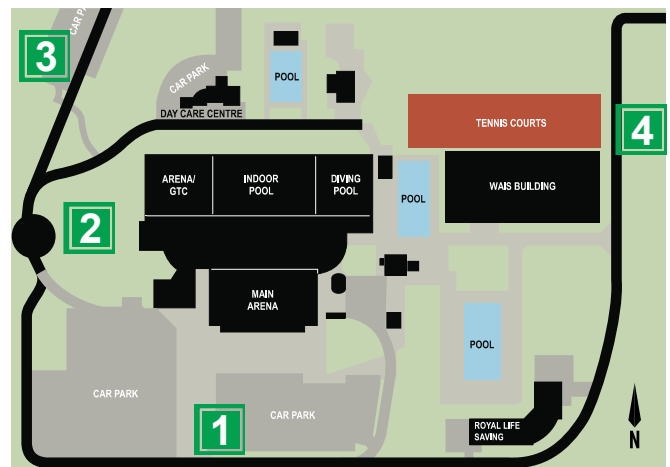
Alert tones:

- **"BEEP, BEEP, BEEP"**
ALERT TONE: Stop – wait for instructions.
- **"WHOOOP, WHOOOP, WHOOOP"**
EVACUATION TONE: Evacuate – follow staff instructions.

EMERGENCY CODES

Code	Reason
RED	Fire / Smoke
PURPLE	Bomb Threat
BLUE	Medical Emergency
BLACK	Armed Offender / Active Shooter / Terrorism
YELLOW	Internal emergency
BROWN	External emergency
ORANGE	Evacuation
PINK	Threatening Behaviour
GREEN	All Clear

ASSEMBLY AREA



- 1** Assemble at road end of southern car park away from immediate danger
- 2** Assemble outside main entrance away from immediate danger
- 3** Assemble on grass area near entrance to precinct away from immediate danger
- 4** Assemble on grass area on McGillivray Oval away from immediate danger

AT THE ASSEMBLY AREA

- Account for people from building
- Report any person missing to the Emergency Services
- **DO NOT** re-enter the building until the "ALL CLEAR" is given by the responding Emergency Services.

- Have concerns about, or information on, threats to Australia's critical information; or
- Believe you have information of possible terrorist activity or have seen or heard something suspicious that may need investigation by security agencies.
